This letter is to cordially invite you, and/or your organization, to participate in the second annual "Frontline Fall Classic" Golf Tournament. This event is organized by employees of the Durham Children's Aid Society. Proceeds generated from the tournament will aid in sending our children and youth to camp.

Through this event, and others organized by the Durham Children's Aid Foundation, one of our many goals is to help all of our disadvantaged "at home" children and youth attend a camp specific to their needs, in the summer of 2011.

We are presently sending children (ages 3 to 18) to approximately 50 day and residential camps in southern Ontario. These camps are typically run by other charities or not-for-profit organizations which focus on helping children with special needs, and/or challenging circumstantial, emotional, and behavioural issues. Please note, these are children who are residing with their biological families, are not in the care of the Society, and consequently do not qualify for government funding. The average cost per camper for a week of camp is approximately \$350.00.

Last year's event was a tremendous success raising over \$6000.00 for the Foundation. Though the generosity of our participants and sponsors we will successfully send 18 children and youth to camp this summer that otherwise would not have had the opportunity to go. With your continued help and support our committee's goal is to exceed that total for the summer of 2011!

Whether you register as a player or as a sponsor, your time, commitment, and generosity will be greatly appreciated by the Society, and most importantly, by the children and their families.
