A summer camp or special recreational / education experience can provide a child or youth with an opportunity to build their sense of self-esteem as well as foster leadership and social skills.

On a daily basis, almost 2,000 children and / or families are involved with our Society in Durham Region. With your help through events such as "Fore the Future" Charity Golf Classic we can change the quality of a child's life forever.

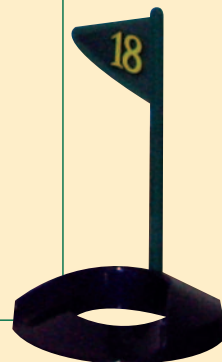
